### **Registration**

Pre-Registration received by mail by or online by October 1st: \$30.00 run/walk with a dog and \$25 run/walk without a dog. Registration after October 1st and on race day: \$35.00 run/walk with a dog and \$30 run/walk without a dog. Participants under the age of 18 will need a parent or guardian signature. There will be no refunds for this fundraiser.

### **Dog Rules**

Competitors (runners or walkers) may be accompanied by a maximum of 2 leashed dogs. Dogs must be on a leash no longer than six feet and under control at all times. Pet clean up bags and trash cans will be provided. All dogs entered must have proof of current rabies vaccinations. NO EXCEPTIONS! Please have your dog wear current I.D. and rabies tags or bring a copy of your current rabies certificate on event day. DO NOT bring your dog if she is in heat. It is recommend dogs less than six months old not participate. Do not bring your dog if its behavior is dangerous. We reserve the right to refuse entry to aggressive animals.

### **Race Details**

Registration begins at 9:00 AM. Race begins promptly at 10:00 AM. Start and finish will be at the Brown County Fair Grounds Centennial Village. Official race timing stops after 45 minutes.

### **Microchip Clinic:**

Get your your pet microchipped right at the fairgrounds! This is a quick and responsible way to ensure your pet can easily be returned to you if they are ever lost. Clinic will be held from 11 AM until 2:00 PM. You do not have to participate in the 5K to take advantage of the microchip clinic. All cats and dogs receiving microchips must have proof of current rabies vaccinations. NO EXCEPTIONS! Please have your cat or dog wear current I.D. and rabies tags or bring a copy of your current rabies certificate on event day. A limited number of microchips will be available, first come first served.

I further assume any and all other risks associated with participating in this event including, but not limited to, illness, travel to or from the event, falls, contact with spectators, other participants or dogs, weather conditions, and the surface conditions of the roads and sidewalks, all such risks being understood and appreciated by me. I also affirm that the dog(s) have current rabies vaccinations. I further agree to abide by all rules of participation for this event. Having read this waiver and knowing these facts, and in consideration of my entry, I hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators or anyone else who might claim on my behalf, covenant not to sue, and waive, release and discharge event officials, volunteers and any other sponsors, suppliers, agents, independent contractors, employees and other personnel in any way assisting with this event from any claims or liability of any kind whatsoever arising out of my participation in this event, carelessness on the part of the persons or parties named in this waiver. I also understand and agree that any sponsor may subsequently use, for promotional or publicity purposes, my name or photos of me and/or my pet(s) without obligation to or permission from me. I acknowledge that I have carefully read this "Waiver and Release" and fully understand that it is a release of liability.
